
To bring high-quality, professional performing arts entertainment, enrichment, and education to Grant County and the surrounding region.

High-Quality Arts Enrichment


For 10 years, Stage Right has provided the residents of Grant County and beyond with high-quality entertainment through our Mainstage musicals and comedies.






9 to 5 the Musical






A Christmas Carol

Rodgers & Hammerstein's Cinderella


January 29 - February 7, 2027




Over 60 KY Counties!
